Professor Richard Wiseman has been described by one Scientific American columnist as '.... the most interesting and innovative experimental psychologist in the world today'. He has written several bestselling popular psychology books (including The Luck Factor, Quirkology, and 59 Seconds), and has sold over 3 million copies worldwide. His research into a range of topics including deception, illusion and persuasion have been published in the world's leading academic journals.

His YouTube channel has received over 350 million views and is one of the most watched channels in the UK. Richard was listed in the Independent On Sunday's top 100 people who make Britain a better place to live, and has acted as a consultant for Derren Brown, Brain Games, Your Bleeped Up Brain, and Mythbusters.

Richard began his working life as a professional magician and is a Member of the Inner Magic Circle. He completed his PhD at the University of Edinburgh and currently holds Britain's only Professorship in the Public Understanding of Psychology (University of Hertfordshire).



Kevin Quantum (AKA McMahon) – Panel Discussion

Kevin annually produces one of the biggest magic events in the world (Edinburgh International Magic Festival) and sells tickets to the public for live magic shows.

He has appeared in BBC documentaries ("Titanic", "Dissection"), consulted for the National Theatre of Scotland and broken a Guinness World Record. He was the first magician to perform a magic act at the Globe Theatre in London, taught Eddie Izzard magic for a recent movie and has produced some of the most inventive performance magic formats in recent years ("The Secret Room", "Tower of Illusion", "Magic a la carte"). He has





also had much recent success with magic-comedy-sketch-group "The Colour Ham" (nominees at Scottish Comedy Awards 2014,2015).

Candice Edmunds graduated from the Royal Conservatoire Scotland with a BA (Acting) in 2002. In 2003 she founded the award-winning Vox Motus with Jamie Harrison. Their aim was to create innovative, visual contemporary theatre that would appeal to their non-arts based peers.

Ours is a theatre of story-telling visuals, transformational design, magic, comedy, music, physical performance, puppetry, multimedia and most importantly thrills.

For Vox Motus Candice has co created and directed Dragon, The Infamous Brothers Davenport, The Not-So-Fatal Death of Grandpa Fredo, Bright Black, Slick, How to Steal a Diamond and Interference. Candice has co-authored all the company's productions, either as a writer or dramaturge. Vox Motus's productions have toured Scotland, England, Ireland,

Germany and China. They have toured Scotland, England, Heland, numerous awards, including the UK Theatre Award for Best Production for Children and Young People 2014 and a Fringe First. Dragon was most recently staged at the Edinburgh International Festival.
